Synthetic floor

40m x 20m

Indoor synthetic floor rules

- All players must have a white adhesive tape all around both Inline skates to protect the synthetic floor.
- Total prohibition of drinking on the track
- Inline skates must be removed outside the track. It is not allowed to go outside the Arena with the Inline skates (between the changing rooms and the arena for example).

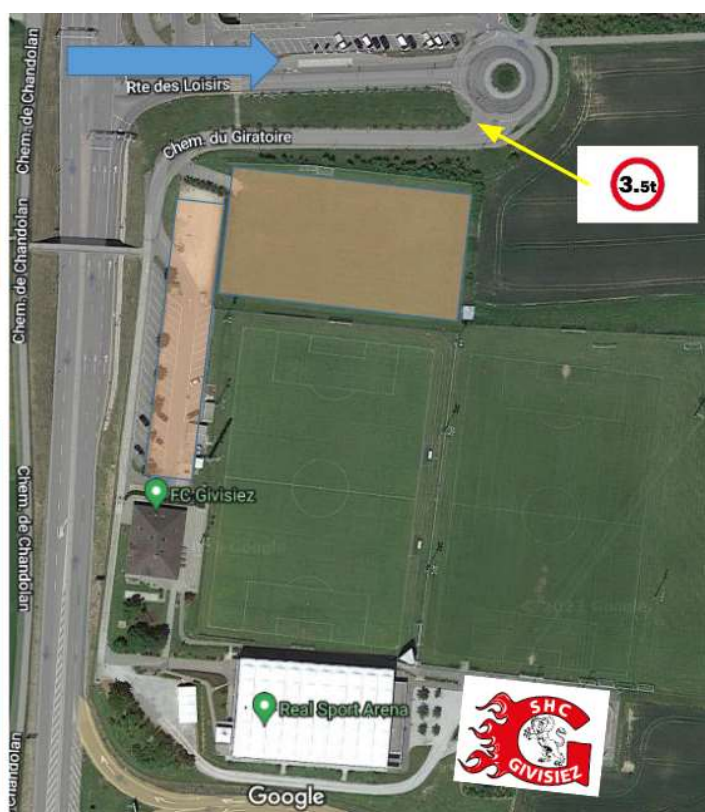

Trainings Sessions

The 16th November 2023, the track will be available for each interested teams for a training session of 60 minutes max.

First aid

First Aid (1 samaritan) will be available at the Arena throughout the tournament.

The main hospital of Fribourg (HFR Fribourg – hôpital cantonal www.h-fr.ch) is very close to the Arena (5-10 minutes by car).

Behaviour

All players and spectators are required to treat the officials, tournament volunteers, other spectators, players and the facilities in an appropriate manner. We look forward to welcome all our guests for the event.

Entry fees

Entry fees for this tournament have to be paid.

- 1 day = 8 CHF (or Euro)
- All week-end = 15 CHF(or Euro)

Presentations ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place on Thursday 16th November 2023 at 18h30 (duration 30 minutes). Participation is mandatory for all teams and officials.

There will be a closing ceremony after the final on Sunday 19th November 2023. Participation is mandatory for all teams and officials as per standard IISHF Title Event rules.
